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Dear Friends of Boroume,

The following pages will give you an opportunity to read a brief description of Boroume's actions in 2020.

Undoubtedly, in 2020 Boroume, like everyone else in the world, experienced significant upsets and challenges in its day-to-day operation such as a drastic reduction in volunteer turnout, the closure of many of our partners (donors and charities) and forced teleworking. Our team, however, not only did not lose its rhythm in saving and offering food, but also created and implemented two new programs, the "Alliance for the Reduction of Food Waste" and "We Are Family – COVID 19".

More specifically, in 2020 we saved & offered almost 9 million portions of food, i.e. as many as in 2019, actively supporting the work of hundreds of charitable institutions throughout Greece, especially in this difficult year. Respecting our organization's principle to achieve the biggest result for the financial support we receive, the ratio of food portions for every 1 € of operating cost was 53 (a 25% increase from 2019).

Along with saving & offering food at every stage of the food chain, we strived again in 2020 to increase awareness about food saving through informational presentations, seminars and our social media channels, by appearing in other media, and through the children we have tried to inspire as part of our educational program "Boroume at School". In this context we launched also our latest and most ambitious initiative, the "Alliance for the Reduction of Food Waste".

However, nothing you will read in the following pages would have been possible without the substantial and ongoing support from many hundreds of food donors, our sponsors and above all, the hundreds of volunteers who again in 2020 chose our organization to give generously of their time and skills.

Chief Food Saving Warrior

It is very difficult to describe with numbers the beautiful feelings that derive from offering food on a daily basis at Boroume. In spite of that, below you can find a snapshot of our actions with numbers:



We saved and offered **8.900.614** portions of food, i.e. **24.385** portions of food per day on average with an estimated value of **13.350.000€** (average cost of 1,5€ per portion)



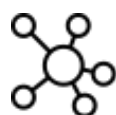
The ratio of offered food portions to the operational costs of our organization was **53 portions per 1€** of operational cost



We placed donations of food from **611** separate donor supplier locations to **435** charitable organizations all over Greece



Boroume's actions were supported by **363** volunteers



We presented our organization to **83** mass media entities, we carried out **23** presentations, **240** companies used Boroume's sticker in **630** stores declaring that they were "Members of Boroume's Saving and Offering Food Network"



We held **56** educational actions which were attended by **1.198** students



We saved and offered **96.600** kilos of fresh fruits and vegetables from **29** farmers' markets in Attica and Thessaloniki with the help of **353** volunteers (from Boroume and other sources)



We converted **1.169.130,60€** of monetary donations into supermarket vouchers, strictly for the purchase of food, which were offered to **39.617** beneficiaries from **200** municipal social service departments that were facing severe food insecurity, as part of our program "We Are Family"

Boroume's actions are based on two pillars::

- saving & offering food through programs that operate at every stage of the food chain ("Saving & Offering Food", "Boroume at the Farmers' Market", "Boroume Gleaning", "We Are Family")
- raising awareness on the issue of food waste and the importance of prevention ("Every Meal Matters", "Boroume at School", "Alliance for the Reduction of Food Waste")

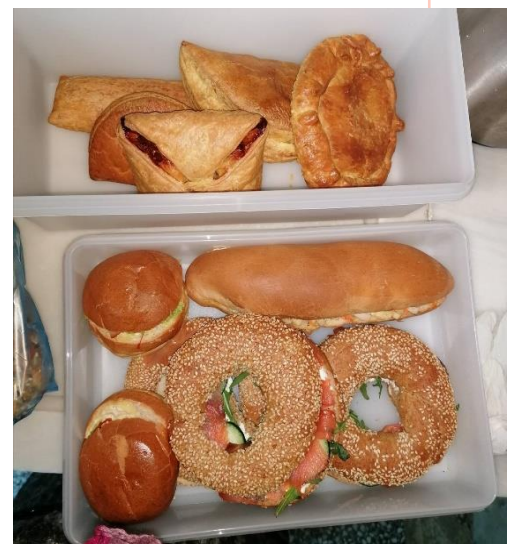
Saving & Offering Food

Boroume's core program aims to reduce food waste and increase food donations to charitable organizations and their beneficiaries, in an easy, fast and direct manner, through its saving & offering food network.

In 2020, **we succeeded in saving and offering the same amount of food as in 2019**, despite many pandemic-related challenges, such as the closure of a large number of our donors (restaurants, catering, events, hotels, etc.), the closure of many of our charitable organization partners due to COVID-19 cases, and the decrease in volunteer turnout due to restrictive measures. More specifically:

- We saved & offered a total of **8.900.614 food portions**, the value of which is estimated at **13.350.000€** using an average of 1.5€ per portion
- On a daily average we offered **24.385 portions of food**
- We increased by 25% the ratio of offered food portions to our total operating costs to **53 portions per 1€ of operating cost**
- **611 donors** offered food with Boroume's help to **435 charitable organizations** all over Greece

Because donations include all types of food and Boroume places the food with charities without storing it, making weighing of the food impossible, the quantification of one food portion is based on calories and specifically 750 calories = 1 food portion



Awareness program "Every Meal Matters"

While saving & offering of food is clearly very important, Boroume believes that substantial behavioral change in reducing food waste will only be achieved by regularly informing the public about its multiple social, environmental and economic benefits.

In 2020, we tried to raise awareness mainly by various actions and a dynamic presence in mass and social media.



Awareness raising actions:

- Presentation about Boroume and its activities at **23 events** in Greece and abroad
- 240 companies have placed the Boroume sticker "**Member of Boroume's Saving & Offering Food Network**" in 630 of their stores as an award for their contributions
- Our monthly newsletter goes out in Greek and English to **2.618** recipients
- Creating communication tools (TV spots, animation, photos and social media posts) and art on the subject of food waste as part of Corteva's "**Lifescore**" program
- Participated in an information & awareness program with information on food waste and practical advice to reduce this in households using an **AB Vassilopoulos brochure**



Mass & social media

Boroume's presence and its activities in mass and social media in 2020 included the following:

- **83 appearances & mentions** in TV, radio and in written and digital press
- 47.683 followers on **facebook**
- 4.367 followers on **twitter**
- 2.417 followers on **Instagram**

Boroume at School

Firmly believing that educating children on the issues of food waste, volunteering and social solidarity constitutes the foundation of a society that will adopt those practices in the future, in 2020 we carried on vigorously with the implementation of our educational program **"Boroume at School"** despite the extremely adverse conditions imposed by the COVID-19 pandemic (closed schools for several months, ban on external partners from entering school premises).

In 2020, we conducted **56 educational programs** that were attended by **1.198 children**.

Other notable actions of the program:

- Coordination of a **multi-day program** to inform pre-school children and infants of the **"Dorothy Snot" Early Childhood Education Centre**, which included reading the book "Dinosaur" in the classrooms, discussions with children, activities with children in the local farmers' market and supermarkets, creation of handicrafts on the subject and as a culmination a food saving party, during which children turned leftover fruits and vegetables from their homes into juices, salads and soups
- Continuation of the **"Lifescore"** program in collaboration with **Corteva** with an all-day event in Larissa, during which company executives, city volunteers and visual artists contributed to the creation of art on food waste, as well as the creation of new animation that was added to the program's informational video-animation
- Continuation of our collaboration with **KMPG** to support our program "Boroume at School"
- Presentation of the educational program for the first time outside Athens and Thessaloniki to 285 kindergarten and primary school students in **Larissa**



Boroume at the Farmers' Market

The **purpose** of the program is to reduce food waste connected to the primary sector of production by making good use of the undisposed products from the producer and trader stalls at farmers' markets and helping in their distribution to local charitable organizations supporting people who are facing food insecurity.

The implementation of the program in 2020 took place under **adverse conditions** which included the reduction of the market benches by 50% over a long period of time, the difficulty of free movement of volunteers specifically those from companies, the closure of many charitable organizations, the sharp fall in the number of volunteers from abroad and the general concern of participating in actions where there are crowds, such as a farmers' market.

Despite the above conditions, the program continued thanks to the **admirable effort of all participants** (donors, volunteers and charitable organizations).

Specifically we accomplished the following:

- We maintained the number of participating farmers' markets at 29 in Attica and Thessaloniki
- We saved and offered a total of 97 tons of fresh fruits and vegetables
- We offered the above quantity directly to 30 local charitable organizations
- We carried out 649 actions of saving and offering fresh products
- 353 volunteers (from Boroume and other sources such as companies, educational institutions) supported the actions of the program
- We coordinated the participation of volunteers from 7 companies and organizations in program actions



Alliance for the Reduction of Food Waste

The Alliance for the Reduction of Food Waste in Greece is a collective effort, in which public authorities, professional and scientific bodies, food and catering companies from all stages of the supply chain, Civil Society organizations, bodies of the academic and research community join forces.



In 2020 we achieved, among other things, the following:

- conducted exploratory contacts, with a view to the **representative composition of the Alliance** with the participation of bodies, organizations and businesses from all parties involved and all stages of the food supply chain in Greece
- prepared, as Alliance Coordinator, the text of the **Voluntary Cooperation Agreement**, which all Alliance Partners are invited to sign
- prepared an advisory document on the Alliance's **"Priority Axis – Areas of Action"**, with proposed initiatives and actions, responding to the main causes and parameters of food waste in order to produce meaningful results
- had an ongoing, constructive cooperation with the **Ministry of Environment and Energy (YPEN)**, which has given its auspices to the Alliance
- **officially launched the Alliance on 29 September** - International Day of Awareness of Food Loss and Waste, celebrated for the first time in 2020 - by teleconference of the original members as well as the personal participation of the Minister of the Environment and Energy
- worked to **expand** the Alliance to **44** Partner Parties

We Are Family

The purpose of the program "We Are Family" is to create "families" of support, consisting of those who wish to help and those facing food insecurity in Greece. This is done through a direct and transparent process which converts all monetary donations into supermarket vouchers strictly for the purchase of food, thus ensuring the beneficiaries' dignity with zero operational costs for the donors.

Within the framework of the **"Global Relief Initiative for the COVID-19 Pandemic"** of the Stavros Niarchos Foundation we were given the opportunity to cooperate using the program "We Are Family". The program was implemented with full success from September to December and concerned the supply of 19.960 supermarket vouchers to meet the emergency food needs of selected beneficiaries of municipal social services throughout Greece.



In total, in 2020:

- **1.169.130,60€** were converted to supermarket vouchers for the purchase of food
- **39.617 beneficiaries** from municipal social service departments were supported
- We cooperated with **200 municipal social service departments**



Collaborations & Actions

Apart from the above programs, in 2020 Boroume participated in European projects, promoted changes in the national legal framework related to food waste, collaborated with charities and networks, and collaborated with companies that supported our goals through CSR actions.

European projects

In 2020, Boroume had the honor to participate in the collective endeavor towards reducing food waste through various forums with many other partners from European countries, as well as to participate in the Horizon 2020 program NEMESIS.

Indicatively we participated in the following:

- by invitation as an expert, in the regular meetings of the **EU Platform on Food Losses and Food Waste**
- in the project **SaveOurFood** whose goal is to create a mechanism to save and offer food in the Municipality of Aglantzia in Cyprus in collaboration with Frederick University

NEMESIS Program

In 2020, we continued our participation with fourteen other partners from six countries in the three-year project NEMESIS funded by the European program for research and innovation **Horizon 2020**.

NEMESIS is a new educational model aimed at developing social innovation skills in primary and secondary school students. It is a European project linking education and social innovation. Boroume participates in the project as a socially innovative organization advising throughout on the co-creation of new social initiatives in Greek schools that participate in the project.

In summary, in 2020 we participated in the following:

- creating a framework for socially innovative education and the **methodology of co-creation** of social initiatives by students
- **designing and implementing co-creation labs** with nine classes of students from the 1st Experimental School of Thessaloniki, the 6th Intercultural Primary School of Kordelio, the Primary School of Klidi - Imathia, the Primary School of Plati - Imathia and the Intercultural Lyceum of Thessaloniki
- an attempt to adapt to the pandemic through the creation of **MOOC** (massive open online course) with all elements of the project

Collaborations

- Participation in the **Action Plan for the Integration of Volunteering** of the United Nations Agenda 2030
- Collaboration with Boussias Communications to create the **1st Food Waste Conference**
- Participation in the second phase of the program **Thales II: Evaluation of Greek Nonprofit Organizations**
- Beginning the collaboration with **nowaste.gr** to prevent food waste by selling leftover products at lower prices before they are withdrawn
- Cooperation with **Espigoladors** from Catalonia to establish an international network of gleaners (saving food in the primary sector)
- Participation in the **HIGGS job-shadowing program** (mentoring at the Social Hackers Academy)
- Participation in research by the **University of Glasgow** on dietary self-sufficiency movements in Athens and Montreal
- Participation in **Connect Your City's "Connected We Stand" initiative** to attract volunteers
- Participation in a "steering committee" of Athens LAB for the project **FoodSHIFT2030**



Advocacy

Almost from the beginning of the creation of Boroume and every time the opportunity has arisen, we contribute to the formulation of a public policy (legislative and non-legislative measures) to effectively tackle food waste and improve the legal framework for NGOs.

In 2020, we had the opportunity to be **particularly active** in this area as we participated in the consultation on a **legislative proposal on Civil Society**, and more importantly because we contributed to the effort to **incorporate European Union legislation on food waste** into national law through close cooperation with the Ministry of Environment and Energy.

Based on our experience of daily activities to save & offer food, and our cooperation with hundreds of donor companies as well as charitable organizations throughout Greece, we have **highlighted issues to clarify/improve and obstacles to remove in the existing legal framework**.

As Coordinator of the Alliance for the Reduction of Food Waste, **we prepared a memo on legislative/regulatory issues in the individual policy areas** with direct or indirect effects on food waste, and **coordinated internal consultation among Members**.

In order to create a favorable framework for the prevention of food waste in Greece, the main guidelines for **proposals we have put forward are below**:

- Crucial to changing citizens' behavior is awareness raising and targeted education to prevent food waste
 - Legislation to ensure the prioritization of measures in accordance with the "reverse pyramid"
 - Encouraging donation of surplus food by clarifying donor and recipient obligations and providing incentives/financial tools, and enhancing the reliability of a donation system (e.g. Register of certified recipient charities)

Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) Actions

As part of Boroume's goals to reduce food waste and increase food donations, in 2020, we collaborated with many companies in order to design and implement various CSR actions that supported these goals.

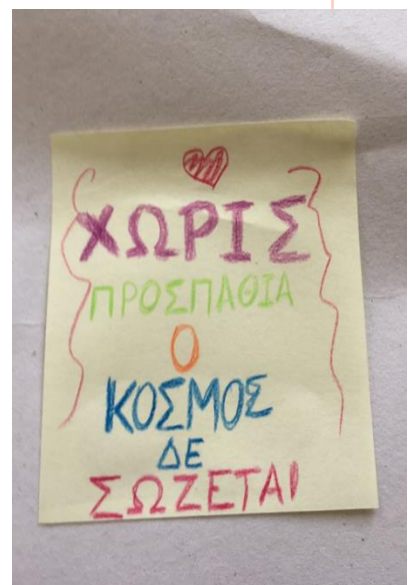
Indicatively, in 2020, we:

- Continued linking 305 AB Vassilopoulos stores with nearby charitable organizations in our effort to reduce food waste at the company's stores. We also continued our collaboration with the company for the seventh year on the "52 Weeks" program.
- participated in an information & awareness program with information on the issue of food waste and practical advice to reduce this in households using an AB Vassilopoulos brochure
- supported Eurocatering – Freskoulis for the fifth year in implementing their program to fully cover the need in fruits and vegetables of 12 charities in Athens and Thessaloniki
- continued Corteva's "Lifescore" program, in which, at one-day social hackathons volunteers, farmers, agronomists and journalists created communication tools (TV spots, animation, photos, social media posts and artwork on the subject of food waste to support Boroume
- continued our collaboration with KMPG to support our "Boroume at School" program
- assisted numerous charities with thousands of food portions that were offered by corporate social responsibility actions of AXA Insurance, Barba Stathis, Association of Executives of Insurance Companies, Dorothy Snot (preschool), JTI, Lia Cultivators, Lidl, Sarantis (Sanitas), PwC
- received support for "Boroume at the Farmers' Market" in 2020 with volunteers from 10 companies & educational institutions: The American College of Greece, Atlas Workshops, Connect Your City, JTI, Pernod Ricard, The Hellenic Initiative Australia, University of Toronto, 1st Lyceum of Kifissia, Hellenic-French School of Ursulines, KETHEA
